

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS – RAM AND EWE BALL 2018**

### **Acceptance of Terms and Conditions**

1. Attendees to the event are deemed to have accepted the terms and conditions contained within this document upon entry to the venue. This is available at the ticketing website and at the venue. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Ram and Ewe Ball Committee ("**the Committee**") is final.

### **Amendments to Terms and Conditions**

2. The Committee reserve the right to amend, add and/or replace any of these terms and conditions. Any such alterations will be published on the Ram and Ewe Ball website prior to the Ball.

### **Ticket Eligibility**

3. You must be aged 18 or over on the night of the Ram and Ewe Ball ("**the Ball**") and be prepared to show valid photographic identification with a Date of Birth as proof to purchase a ticket.
4. The Committee reserves the right to withdraw tickets from any purchaser or attendee found breaking these terms and conditions.

### **Cancellation and refunds**

5. Before purchasing tickets, carefully review your ticket selection.
6. The price of the ticket shall be the price set at the time we accept your order.
7. No order will be accepted until we have received full payment in cleared funds. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any booking which it suspects to have been made fraudulently.
8. The Committee cannot offer you a refund if you can no longer attend the Ball or due to any change in your personal circumstances, however you may give your ticket(s) to another person to use provided you notify the Committee in writing prior to the Ball.
9. The Committee will only offer a refund or exchange of a ticket if the Ball is cancelled, rescheduled or significantly relocated by the Committee (and you cannot or do not wish to attend the rescheduled or relocated event), or to the extent otherwise required by law (including the Australian Consumer Law). You must apply for a refund within a reasonable time.
10. If the Ball is cancelled, rescheduled or significantly relocated by the Committee, all liability is limited to the amount for which the ticket was purchased (including any fees or charges). Proof of purchase may be required for any refund or exchange. Unless required by law (including the Australian Consumer Law), the Committee will not be liable for any other losses incurred by you as a result of the cancellation, rescheduling or relocation of the Ball, including any travel and accommodation expenses.

11. You should carefully consider the refund and cancellation policies of travel, accommodation and other goods or service providers when making arrangements for attendance at the Ball. You may also wish to consider taking out a relevant insurance policy to cover for any losses in the Ball of cancellation, rescheduling or relocation.
12. No refund is available on any tickets purchased inside the venue (this includes but is not limited to drink and photobooth tickets).

### **Conditions of Admission and attendance (Refusal of Entry / Entry Conditions)**

13. Attendance at the Ball constitutes consent for an authorised photographer nominated by the Committee to take photos which may be used for advertising purposes. For clarity, this is regardless of whether or not you have purchased a ticket directly from the ticketing website or at the venue.
14. In addition to Clause 13, any photos taken on premises by an authorised photographer nominated by the Committee will remain property of the Committee (including photos taken in the photobooth).
15. No person under 18 years of age will be admitted to the venue.
16. The Committee reserves the right to refuse ticket holder's admission to the Ball **and** the right to request that a ticket holder leave the venue at any point on reasonable grounds. The Committee reserves the right to take any appropriate action to enforce this in reasonable circumstances. By way of example, the venue may remove a ticket holder who:
  - 16.1. fails, when required, to produce proof of identity or age;
  - 16.2. fails to adhere to the dress code policy as stated in Appendix A;
  - 16.3. prevents, refuses, or stops the authorised security personnel from searching the ticket holder for weapons, drugs or any other illicit or dangerous substances.
17. The Committee reserves the right to act as it deems necessary in the interest of safety and security. In order to maintain safety and security in the Ball, the Committee reserves the right to eject any person from the Ball and to take whatever further action they think appropriate. Grounds for such exclusion include, but are not exclusive to:
  - 17.1. behaviour in the Venue in a manner which, in the reasonable opinion of the Committee or it's authorised security personnel has, or is likely to affect the enjoyment of other visitors;
  - 17.2. the use of threatening, abusive or insulting words or behaviour
  - 17.3. behaviour which in any way may provoke a breach of the peace including but not limited to:
    - 17.3.1. Indecent, illegal or immoral behaviour;
    - 17.3.2. Behaviour subject to suspected excessive consumption of alcohol;
    - 17.3.3. Consumption or under the influence of drugs or illicit substances;
    - 17.3.4. Possession of illegal or dangerous substances.

18. No refunds will be given to ticket holders who are refused entry or ejected due to their own behaviour as suggested in, but not limited to, the examples above.
19. You must comply with instructions and directions given by Committee, event volunteers and security.
20. If you suffer any injury or illness, you agree the Committee's medical contractor or any other third party medical service provider can administer any first aid and/or medical treatment and facilitate transport and/or evacuation you seek, or as is reasonably necessary in the circumstances (the costs of which you are responsible for).
21. Your entry into the premises constitutes your consent to first aid, medical treatment, transport and/or evacuation as may be reasonably necessary. Furthermore, you agree to reimburse the Committee for any costs or expenses incurred in providing such first aid, medical treatment, transport and/or evacuation.

### **Conditions of Camping on Grounds (prior to and post the Ball)**

22. You agree to indemnify and release the Committee against all future actionable claims in relation to camping on the grounds surrounding the event location prior to and/or after the Ball.
23. The Committee is NOT responsible for any actions or omissions that occur outside the event hours.
24. You are responsible for abiding by the local laws in relation to the consumption of alcohol, noise levels and appropriate behaviour in public places. Please consult the Northern Areas Council for more information.

### **Severance**

25. A clause or part of a clause of this document that is illegal or unenforceable may be severed from this document and the remaining clauses or parts of the clause of this document continue in force.

### **Appendix A – Dress Code**

**The only acceptable attire is Formal wear.** The dress code will be strictly enforced, and those not properly attired will be refused entry into the Ball.

The following attires and/or accessories are not permissible wear:

- Baseball caps, peaked caps or beanies;
- Sunglasses;
- Denim, jodhpurs, shorts, untailored pants or playsuits, leggings worn as pants;
- Any form of the following footwear; joggers, sports shoes, track shoes, runners, thongs, dilapidated footwear, scuffs, gumboots or slippers;

- Parkas, windbreakers, tracksuit tops, denim jackets or anoraks, leather bomber jackets or pullovers;
- Tracksuits;
- Fancy dress costumes;
- Tattered clothing or shoes;
- Offensive attire (inappropriate language and/or imagery);
- Torn or ripped clothing;
- Sports attire; and
- No open neck shirts or shirts with no collar.
